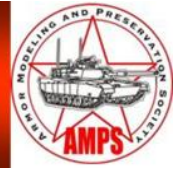

## *Armor, Figure, and Diorama Modeling Contest and Exhibition*

Dear Friends:

It is that time again, on Friday & Saturday, September 23 & 24; the Northeast Military Modelers Association will host their twelfth annual plastic model contest and exhibition: **IPMS AMPSEAST 2011**. This two day event will be held at the Danbury Plaza Hotel in Danbury, Connecticut. It will include over thirty-scale armor, figure, and diorama modeling categories in three different skill levels. It will also feature vendor tables, raffles, door prizes, as well as modeling and research seminars.

I am new to the team but the rest of the team producing **IPMS AMPSEAST 2011** is made up of the same people who staged last year's event. They have a great deal of experience organizing modeling events at the local, regional, and national level. The enormous success of last year's show is ample evidence of their skills, determination, and hard work. AMPS EAST 2010 drew over **407** armor, figure, and diorama modeling enthusiasts that exhibited 195 entries. These folks came from throughout the Eastern United States and Canada, and all were ecstatic with the Danbury Plaza Hotel's outstanding facilities. This year's show theme is "Artillery, the King of Battle," and looks to be even bigger and better than last year!

As I discussed above, **IPMS AMPSEAST 2011** is a team effort. **We need you to become part of the team!** As a team member, you have the opportunity to help us, and, at the same time, promote your business, product, or activity. **There are three ways that you can help support the team:**
